CAMP SLAYER, IZ, WITNESSED THE USE OF "HARSH" TECHNIQUES, WHILE WORKING IN THE TEMPORARY DETENTION FACILITY AT THIS CONDUCT BECAUSE HE FELT THE ACTIONS WERE INHUMANE EVEN THOUGH EVERY "HARSH" INTERROGATION WAS APPROVED BY THE J2 OF THE TASK FORCE AND THE MEDICAL PERSONNEL PRIOR TO ITS EXECUTION. HE SAID A GUARD WAS REPRIMANDED FOR GIVING A HOODED DETAINEE A WATER BOTTLE, WHICH CONTAINED URINE, TO DRINK. MR. STATED HE DID NOT WITNESS THE INCIDENT BUT HEARD ABOUT IT FROM THE NCOIC HE COULD ONLY IDENTIFY AS MR. RELATED OTHER HARSH TECHNIQUES, WHICH WERE USED WERE SLEEP DEPRIVATION, 20-HOUR INTERROGATION SESSIONS, MOPPING FLOORS, AND ALSO BELIEVED THE HANDCUFFS WERE TOO TIGHT AND CAUSED BRUISING. MR. PROVIDED A WRITTEN LOCATION OF THE FACILITY AND ALSO A WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE LAYOUT OF THE FACILITY.
